

Summer Intensive Program Contract 2026

Summer Religious Education is offered to our parishioners as an alternative to the traditional once a week class format that is held in the fall. Students entering First Grade through Eighth Grade are eligible to attend the program provided all previous year requirements have been fulfilled.

****There are no makeup classes, therefore every session must be attended in its entirety.***

Snacks:

Please provide bottled water (no glass containers) together with a **peanut-free**, healthy snack daily for your child

Following the Rules:

- **NO** candy, gum, or snacks in the classrooms.
- **ELECTRONIC DEVICES** are not to be used. I understand that if my device is seen or heard it will be taken and returned after class. At the second offense the device will be returned directly to my parents. At the third offense there will be a parent conference.
- **LISTENING** when others are speaking.
- **ARRIVING ON TIME FOR CLASSES** The opportunity to pray and learn about the Catholic faith is jeopardized when a child is consistently arriving late, as arrivals are very disruptive.
- **WALKING TO AND FROM CLASSES** in an orderly respectful way.
- **TAKING CARE OF ALL** Church, school, and personal property.
- **DRESS CODE** – Clothing must be modest, and no one will be permitted to wear any clothing with inappropriate language

Mandatory Participation:

- All Summer Program students and parents are required to attend a minimum of two (2) Liturgical Sessions offered at the Church of Epiphany. One (1) session for Advent/Christmas and one (1) sessions for Lent/Easter
- **Weekly Mass and Homily Reflections:** Students are required to attend weekly Mass and write fourteen (14) Homily Reflections dated and stamped with the raised seal from July 1, 2026, through Easter 2027. Fourteen Masses: Three (3) are required to be grade Masses which are posted on the website, Christmas Mass, Easter Mass, and nine (9) Sunday Masses at Epiphany of your choosing.
- **Penance Service:** Students are required to attend class Penance Service during the fall/winter. Please refer to the Penance Schedule for dates.
- **Sacramental Preparation:** Students in grades 2nd & 8th.

If any of the above requirements are not met, the student will not be eligible for the following year's summer program and/or Sacrament.
